### APPELLATION NOTES

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC is in the Abruzzo region of East Central Italy between the Apennines foothills to the Adriatic coast. This is one of Italy's most mountainous regions with more than 65% of Abruzzo being considered mountainous terrain reaching up to 2,750 meters above sea level. The hillside vineyards are planted on calcareous clay and benefit from warm and significant sun exposure while its proximity to the Adriatic Sea ensures the vineyards are ventilated by dry breezes from the coast.

### TASTING NOTES

Montepulciano is known for its deep colour, firm tannins and crisp fresh acidity. It bursts with red fruit flavours of sour cherry, red plum, cranberry and raspberry jam layered with aromas of hints of oregano, dried herbs, pepper, tobacco, and slight savoury earthiness.
