TRIPLE OAK

BEARFACE Triple Oak is a single grain Canadian whisky matured in ex-bourbon American oak barrels, then aged in French oak red wine casks and air-dried virgin Hungarian oak.





AMERICAN OAK

Our single-grain Canadian whisky is aged in exbourbon American oak barrels to impart notes of honey, butter and natural vanilla.

Tasting notes: Honey, marzipan, crème brûlée, butter and natural vanilla.

FRENCH OAK

Three vintages of heavy-red, tight-grain, French oak casks are used to impart dry fruit notes of cranberry and pear, along with a rich Canadian red colour.

Tasting notes: Dry fruits and cranberry. Subtle flavors of saffron, balsamic, apricot and a hint of pear.

HUNGARIAN OAK

After being air-dried for three years, our virgin Hungarian oak is toasted three ways. This imparts a unique spice with rye-like notes as well as BBQ and a gentle smoke.

Tasting notes: Spice, black cardamom, orange peel, mandarin, brown sugar and smoke.
