The Balvenie DoubleWood is a 12-year-old single malt whisky which gains its distinctive character from being matured in two casks.

Launched in 1993, the expression uses a process pioneered by The Balvenie Honorary Ambassador and Former Malt Master David C. Stewart MBE in the 1980's, now commonly known as "cask finishing."

Aged to 12 years in traditional second-fill American Oak casks, it is then transferred to a first-fill European oak sherry cask for maturation, bringing depth and fullness of flavor. Each stage lends different qualities to the resulting extraordinary single malt whisky.

Our dedicated craftspeople pour their soul and obsession into every single bottle. Nowhere else can you find a distillery that grows its own barley, malts in its own traditional floor maltings and still employs a team of coopers to tend to the casks alongside a coppersmith to maintain the stills. All while The Balvenie Malt Master Kelsey McKechnie presides over the all-important maturation process.
