The flavors on the palate are blackberry, boysenberry and nutmeg, cascading into cinnamon sugar, orange cream, dried herbs and a dry, silky finish. Pair with grilled ribeye steak.”

HISTORY

Like elephants whose size is imposing, Petite Petit is large! A blend of 85% Petite Sirah and 15% Petit Verdot.

Offering a joyous explosion of color and fun, it is a substantial, dense, full-bodied, whopper style of wine loaded with pure black fruit and vanilla flavors that coat the palate. It reveals remarkable richness with a finish that is slightly dry and seems to linger.
