Our Rosso & Bianco wines have always been very special to us. Not only do they pay tribute to our family's heritage, they're some of the first wines we ever created. As a way of honoring this beloved brand, we designed a new work-of-art for the label.

The 2013 Rosso offers dark, succulent flavors of cherries, wild berries and fragrant spices. With a plush mouthfeel, medium weight and a touch of oak and tannin, this highly versatile red wine pairs beautifully with anything from grilled meats to rich sauces and hearty pasta dishes.

Appearance: Garnet red

Aromas: Wild raspberries, plums, allspice and tobacco Flavors: Boysenberries, black cherries, smoky oak and vanilla

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

- The fruit for Rosso is grown in Lodi, where warm sunny days give way to cool afternoons and
 evenings. This temperature differential slows the ripening process and allows the grapes to
 develop concentration and complexity.
- The varied nuances in this wine are the result of blending varietals: Zinfandel offers sweet, juicy
 fruit flavors and spice notes, Syrah gives the wine a velvety texture, Cabernet Sauvignon lends red
 fruit and structure, and Petite Sirah provides density.
- 2013 delivered ideal growing conditions, making two great vintages in a row. With little rain and
 no temperature extremes, our grapes ripened steadily and developed great concentration, excellent
 texture and balance, and rich, luscious fruit flavors.
