THE INSPIRATION



TINCUP, CO was an old mining town set on the western side of the Rockies named after the old cups the miners would drink from. The name TINCUP Whiskey and the cap on the bottle are both nods to this piece of Colorado history. After all, when the miners came through Colorado they didn't ask for a mango-infused vodka – they wanted whiskey.

High rye bourbon cut with pure Rocky Mountain water.

64% CORN



32% RYE



4% MALTED BARLEY
