

2015 NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

ABOUT THE WINE: Aged for six months in HIGH WEST RYE WHISKEY BARRELS, Cooper & Thief Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a rich wine with warm, dark fruit aromas, a lush mouthfeel, and supple tannins, touched by hints of toasted rye spice. It is COMPLEX ON THE PALATE AND FINISHES WITH A SMOOTH STRUCTURE reminiscent of a fine rye whiskey.

VINTAGE: 2015 brought out nature's mischievous side. The season started without a single drop of rain in January. The dry, warm weather continued, until a cool patch set up a light crop in May. Fortunately, we dodged late-season heat waves to bring in a small, yet ripe and flavorful harvest in September and October.

- 80% Cabernet Sauvignon
- 14% Merlot
- 4% Cabernet France
- 2% Petit Verdot

SOURCING: Fruit for our Cooper & Thief Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the valley's most renowned sub-appellations and vineyards. The varying mesoclimates and soils of these vineyards elicit a wonderfully concentrated and expressive Cabernet. Blended with fruit from a number of the area's other fine vineyards and STASHED IN RYE WHISKEY BARRELS FOR SIX MONTHS, our Cooper & Thief Cabernet Sauvignon is rich and complex with smooth, toasted rye spice notes.
