WINEMAKER NOTES

Our 2017 Pinot Noir is light purple in color and is bursting with aroma and flavor, leading with ripe red cherry, strawberry cream, and raspberry notes. The wine is silky on the palate with red fruit and vanilla undertones, culminating in a clean, lasting finish.

HARVEST & PRODUCTION NOTES

Over 90% of the fruit for our 2017 Pinot Noir came from Lodi. The remainder came from McManis' own River Junction AVA as well as other sustainable vineyards throughout the northern interior of the Valley.

The grapes for our 2017 Pinot Noir were harvested between August 29th and September 14th, 2017, with an average Brix of 25.1. After fermenting on the skins for 6-9 days, the must was pressed and the resulting wine finished fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine then received the equivalent of approximately 6 months of aging on French and American oak.

BLEND

Our blend is predominantly Pinot Noir with a small amount of Petite Sirah added in for texture & color.
