- Leinenkugel's Oktoberfest turns faster than top fall seasonals Oktoberfest/Märzen style up 11% in the fall vs. YA

A: Caramel malt overtones with moderate fruit/ester aroma

T: Caramel malt flavors with spicy hop undertones, balance slightly skewed to the malty sweet side

M: Medium body

F: Crisp, clean and refreshingly malty
