

First Peach Ale: A Belgian-inspired Brown Ale with a slightly tart peach note balanced with caramel malts

The Name “First Peach Ale”

- The first peach is the one that’s not yet ripe, tart and has that fresh, just-picked taste – this is the early season and resembles the coming of spring. This is First Peach Ale. When thinking about summer peaches, you envision sweet, ripened peaches, which is not representative of this tart, yet balanced, ale.
- After testing different names with consumers, they gravitated to “First Peach Ale” as it best tells the story of our not quite ripe, fresh, just-picked, tart taste of the beer balanced by caramel malts.

First Peach Ale Profile / Beer Intrinsic

- **Appearance:** Clear, deep amber-colored ale with an off-white head.
- **Aroma:** Assertive, peach aroma with a hint of caramel malt.
- **Taste:** Notable natural peach taste with a light caramel malt sweetness and mild tartness.
- **Mouthfeel:** Medium body with hint of dryness
- **Finish:** Light peach flavor with mild tartness and slight sweetness
- **Food Pairings:** Salads, Fruit salads, Peach and Vanilla desserts
- **ABV:** 5.6%
